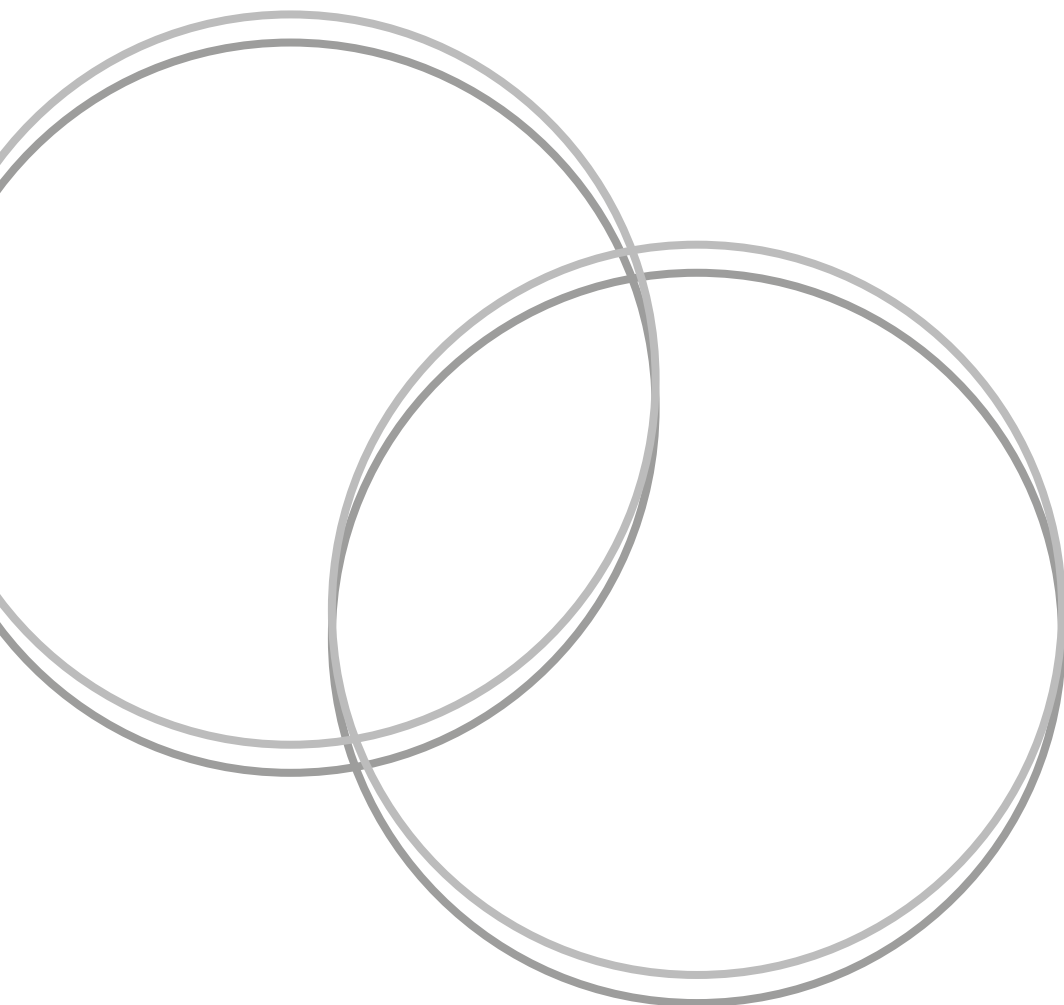

Antenatal and Postnatal care

We hold antenatal clinics everyday and offer Glucose Tolerance testing clinics **twice a week**. Please speak to your Midwife for details of the times that these clinics are held.

We also provide postnatal support for you and your baby when you get home from hospital. We usually visit you at home the day after you are discharged from hospital between 9.00am and 4.00pm. After this, we can see you at drop-in postnatal clinics that are held every day, speak to you over the phone or visit you at home between 9.00am and 4.00pm.
